A. DAY TRIPS AND SAFARIS (all min. of two people, pick up from Glen Loy or Fort William)

Full Day Trip A day of wildlife watching with Glenloy Wildlife in an all-inclusive tour. Trips are by minibus and generally last from around 9.30am to 6.30pm, with lunch included. Explore the fascinating landscape and wildlife of Lochaber. These can be tailored to your requirements and wishes, but would generally include searches for eagles, otters, deer and a wealth of other wildlife, with at least one easy walk of at least an hour included. Options also include a boat trip to look for eagles, marine wildlife or even a funicular ride up Cairngorm to look for ptarmigan and other mountain creatures.

Half-day safaris - a 4 hour trip by minibus to spot wildlife and enjoy a short walk looking at the local environment and typical habitats. Location and species depends on season and weather.

Blackcock and Otter Safari – seasonal early-morning trips to watch the black grouse lekking at a local site, using the minibus as a hide, and to look for otters fishing. Times will vary according to season, but the trip will be approximately 2.5- 3 hours in duration, returning in time for breakfast.

B. PINE MARTEN AND OTHER WILDLIFE BREAKS

Spend the evening on a bed and breakfast basis at Glenloy Lodge and spend an unlimited time watching pine martens and other wildlife at the lodge. Use our local knowledge to guide you towards other local wildlife on breaks of two or more days. Why not incorporate a guided trip with Glenloy Wildlife during your break?
